

Projection and 1000-meter grid ticks shown in blue:  
Universal Transverse Mercator, zone 3  
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 7, 1927 North American Datum  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 99 meters north and 132 meters east  
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-29, Seward Meridian  
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs  
Lake elevations are uncheckd  
Federal reservation boundaries established by The Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act, PL 96-487, Dec. 2, 1980, are shown as compiled by the administering agencies

The Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge consists of all the public lands in the coastal waters and adjacent seas of Alaska consisting of islands, islets, rocks, reefs, capes and spires, as well as designated mainland areas
