


 To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 61 meters north and 112 meters east  
 Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio CR-5, Copper River Meridian  
 Lake elevations are unchecked  
 Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
